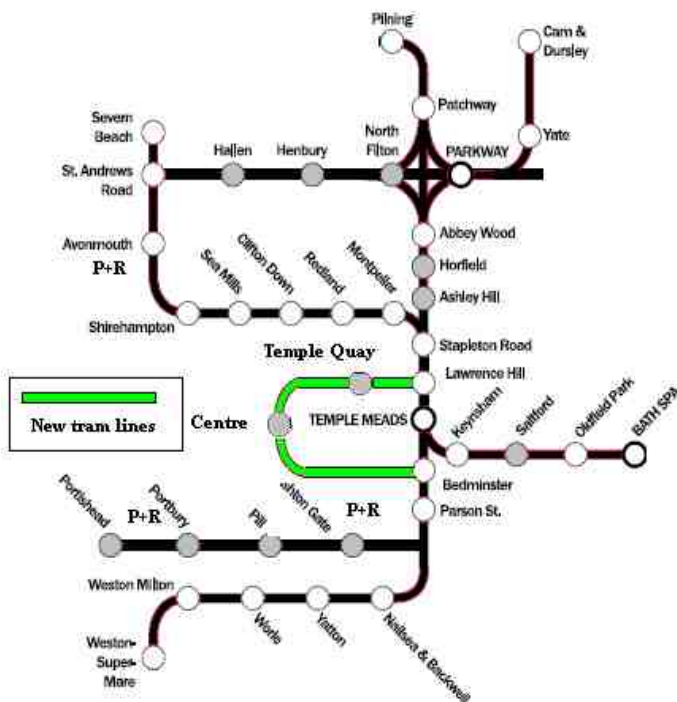
Campaigning for Light Rail

Why Bristol needs Tram-train?



- Light rail can run on former railway lines, alongside highways or in the street as a tramway.
- It can share tracks with train services to maximise use of the rail lines.

- Tram systems can access the heart of the city.
- They can share the city space with pedestrians.
- Light rail takes people right to where they want to go



- Combined with the proposed Bristol Metro a link to the Centre would be able to revitalise local rail services.
- It could serve several P+R sites with a 10 minute service.
- The short length of new track would keep costs down.
- Could encourage redevelopment in a way the proposed busways would not achieve.
- Provide 1st class transport for Bristol!
